- 1) 1,288' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 1 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 2) 1,321.6' SOUTH TO THE 18" X 7" X 3" LIMESTONE HE SET IN THE GROUND FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 2 THAT HE CALLED THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13
