

NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 96 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A SANDSTONE 18" X 10" X 3"** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON JANUARY 1, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 39.35 CHAINS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 22" X 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 16 & 17 SOUTH, RANGES 12 7 13 EAST AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13
 - 2) 3.60 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE SAC & FOX INDIAN LANDS
 - 3) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 20" X 18" X 3" SANDSTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5 & 6-17-13
- 2) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** NUMBER 63 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 61 DATED JULY, 1870, TO DIVIDE THE (WATERLOO TOWNSITE) NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6 INTO FIVE PARTS OF EQUAL VALUE, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 17 AND RANGE 13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 358 LINKS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE SAC & FOX LINE
- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, BY FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 212 DATED MAY 23 & 24, 1878 ORDERED BY THOMAS C. NICCUM FOR A SURVEY IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE **LYING LOOSE ON THE GROUND**, SOME 20 FEET SOUTH OF A HOLE THAT HE FOUND BY DIGGING. HE SAID THAT THE STONE THAT HE FOUND BY DIGGING WAS "A PIECE OF SANDSTONE-EVIDENTLY A PART OF THE 1/4 CORNER STONE". **HE SET THE STONE** AT THIS PLACE FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE USED THIS STONE AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 TO **RESET** THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE.

- 4) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, BY HOWARD E. BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 91 BY THE NOTICE OF WILL WHITMORE TO DETERMINE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND LOT 2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED APRIL 9, 10, 11, 16 & 17, 1913. SEE PACKET "M 177" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 234.3' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE INDIAN LINE AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1
- 2) 2,658.48' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13
- 3) 2,574' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-13 AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER

- 5) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 150, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 231 DATED MAY 8, 1906 FOR THE MILLER BROTHERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER, THE EAST 1/4 CORNER, THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19; THE SOUTHEAST CORNER AND THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20; THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER, SOUTHEAST CORNER, EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31, AND THE LINE BETWEEN THE EAST AND WEST 1/2 OF THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 32, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 13; AND ALSO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER, NORTHEAST CORNER, SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 12 AND OTHER SUCH CORNERS AND LINES CONNECTING THEREWITH AS MAY BE NECESSARY, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE DETERMINED THE LOCATION** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 84" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 4 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 39.57 CHAINS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-13 AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER
- 2) 3.55 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE SET ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-13
- 3) 40.23 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-13
- 4) 60.29 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 32-16-13
- 5) 80.35 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE **LOCATION** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-13
- 6) 120.47 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE **LOCATION** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-13
