

**NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 617 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 2, 3, 10 & 11-17-13 ON THE COUNTY LINE ON OCTOBER 11, 1860.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 2 & 3-17-13
  - 2) 79.40 CHAINS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 22" X 16" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 2 & 3-17-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
  - 3) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 11" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 10 & 11-17-13
  - 4) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 32" X 6" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 10, 11, 14 & 15-17-13
  - 5) 40.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE 17" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 3 & 10
  - 6) 80.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3, 4, 9 & 10
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 173 AND DATED MAY 1904, ORDERED BY J. W. MAVITY, OSAGE COUNTY SURVEYOR AT THE REQUEST OF J. J. DAHL, AGENT FOR TILLIE SLUSSER, AND CHARLES LINDBLOOM OF OSAGE COUNTY FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 3-17-13 AND THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 34-16-13 ON THE LYON AND OSAGE COUNTY LINE AND RUN SUCH LINES AS NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE SECTION CORNER AT THE CORNER OF A STONE WALL** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 3-17-13 ON THE LYON AND OSAGE COUNTY LINE ON THIS JOINT **PERMANENT SURVEY** WITH THE OSAGE COUNTY SURVEYOR. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK 2 ON PAGE 46 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 135" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 7 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 39.82 CHAINS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-17-13
- 2) 79.32 CHAINS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 22" X 9" X 2" STONE WITH A "+" ON THE SOUTH SIDE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 3-17-13
- 3) 119.24 CHAINS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND LOOSE ON THE GROUND NEARBY AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-13
- 4) 159.16 CHAINS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-13
