

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) L. P. HUNTOON, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 55, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 64 DATED MAY 7, 1870 TO DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-17-13 INTO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH-SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-17-13 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 40.04 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-17-13
  - 2) 19.83-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE 4" DIAMETER MULBERRY POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-17-13
  - 3) 39.67 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-17-13
