

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) L. P. HUNTOON, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 63-1/2, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 62 DATED MAY 7, 1870 TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-13, STATES THAT HE RAN EAST FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-17-13 AND INTERSECTED THE LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH THROUGH SECTION 17-17-13 AT AN ASH TREE 16" IN DIAMETER MARKED "CC" AT 4 FEET ABOVE THE GROUND ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 15.06-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE LIMESTONE THAT HE SET FOR A PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER
  - 2) 40.14 CHAINS BY HIS NOTES [40.12 CHAINS ON HIS DRAWING] WEST TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-17-13
