

WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 631 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 13" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 17 & 18-17-13.

- 2) L. P. HUNTOON, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 63-1/2, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 62 DATED MAY 7, 1870 TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-13, STATES THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-17-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 25.07-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE LIMESTONE THAT HE SET FOR A PROPERTY CORNER
 - 2) 40.14 CHAINS BY HIS NOTES [40.12 CHAINS ON HIS DRAWING] EAST TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH THROUGH THE SECTION AT AN ASH TREE 16" IN DIAMETER MARKED "CC" AT 4' ABOVE THE GROUND

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, BY FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 210 DATED MAY 14, 1878 ORDERED BY H. F. HOLMES TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF HIS LAND IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-17-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 150 RODS, 21 LINKS WEST TO THE 1-1/2' LONG BY 2" THICK STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST PROPERTY CORNER AT THE INTERSECTION WITH THE EAST-WEST CENTERLINE OF SECTION 18-17-13 AND THE WEST BOUNDARY LINE OF THE SAC & FOX INDIAN TRUST LANDS

- 4) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 93 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 374 TO 376 PETITION BY JOHN HOLMES AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN SECTION 18-17-13 [PACKET 345 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON DECEMBER 1, 1880, AND WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 5, 1881 AS NOTED BY I. A. TAYLOR, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 5, 1881 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-17-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 2,640' TO THE SOUTH-EAST CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-13 FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD APPARENTLY EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 30'; THEN EXTENDS WEST PARALLEL TO THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 1,282' TO AVOID A HEDGE FENCE; THEN EXTENDS NORTH 30' TO THE 1/4 SECTION LINE; THEN CONTINUES WEST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 3,978' TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 18-17-13 ON THE RANGE LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 5) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE LEFT SIDE PAGE 185 DATED DECEMBER 2, 1880, FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 17-13, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE**

STONE AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-17-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 2,640' TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-13 FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD APPARENTLY EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 30'; THEN EXTENDS WEST PARALLEL TO THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 1,282' TO AVOID A HEDGE FENCE; THEN EXTENDS NORTH 30' TO THE 1/4 SECTION LINE; THEN CONTINUES WEST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 3,978' TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 18-17-13 ON THE RANGE LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 6) **COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 71**
ON JANUARY 18, 1951 A PETITION SIGNED BY ED ROBINSON FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 17-13 WAS PRESENTED TO GEORGE K. JACKSON, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND R. W. BALL, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON FEBRUARY 9, 1951 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON MARCH 13, 1951 **VACATED** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
- 1) BEGINNING ON THE QUARTER CORNER ON THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 18-17-13, THENCE EAST THROUGH SAID SECTION TO THE EAST SIDE OF SECTION 18-17-13, A DISTANCE OF ONE MILE, AND ENDING THERE.
