

**NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 616 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT THEY SET A **LIMESTONE 26" X 13" X 2"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 14, 15, 22 & 23-17-13 ON THE COUNTY LINE ON OCTOBER 11, 1860.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 21" X 13" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 22 & 23-17-13
  - 2) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 22, 23, 26 & 27-17-13
  - 3) 40.12 CHAINS WEST TO THE 19" X 14" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 & 22
  - 4) 80.25 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 15, 16, 21 & 22
  
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 11, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 11 DATED FEBRUARY 15-18, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 15-16-21-22 AND TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 15, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 17, RANGE 13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-13 ON THE LYON AND OSAGE COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 2,659' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-13
  
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 148 AND DATED SEPTEMBER 1886, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22-17-13 ON THE LYON AND OSAGE COUNTY LINE ON THIS SURVEY.
