- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 29 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 84 DATED JUNE 26, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER AND TO PART OFF 40 ACRES FROM THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-17-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A 16" X 10" X 3" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-17-13 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY.**

- 1) 660' EAST TO THE 12" X 10" X 2" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CORNER OF THE 40 ACRE LOT
