

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 118 DATED MARCH 3, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF W. JACOBY'S LAND, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, AND TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-13 NORTH AND SOUTH, SAID THAT HE RAN LINES CONNECTING THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS. HE SET A TEMPORARY POST AT 160 RODS EAST OF THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13, AND A TEMPORARY POST AT 160 RODS NORTH OF THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13. THE TEMPORARY POSTS NOT BEING AT THE SAME PLACE, HE PROJECTED ANGLES AND BROUGHT THEM TOGETHER AND **HE ESTABLISHED** THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13. HE DID **NOT** SAY WHAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13.
