- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 118 DATED MARCH 3, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF W. JACOBY'S LAND, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, AND TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-13 NORTH AND SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE ESTABLISHED** THE NORTH 1/2/44 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-13 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 78 RODS, 8-3/4 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13
- 2) 78 RODS, 8-3/4 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13
