

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 628 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-17-13 AT 40.00 CHAINS EAST OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER. THEY SAID THAT AT 40.70 CHAINS EAST OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-17-13, THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 12" X 2" AT A POINT ON THE SAC & FOX LANDS BEING 22.48 CHAINS NORTH OF A STONE THAT WAS SET ON SAID LINE FOR THE CORNER TO FRACTIONAL SECTIONS 30 & 31-17-13.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE 22" X 12" X 3-1'2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-17-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
 - 2) 0.70 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 12" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE SAC & FOX RESERVATION LANDS
 - 3) 40.14 CHAINS EAST TO THE 17" X 14" X 4" SANDSTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 29, 30, 31 & 32-17-13
- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 118 DATED MARCH 3, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF W. JACOBY'S LAND, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, AND TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-13 NORTH AND SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13 ON THIS SURVEY.

- 1) 320 RODS, 20 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-13
