

**CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 28 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM DATED JUNE 25, 2874, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK “C” ON PAGE 83 TO ESTABLISH THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13 AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO THE EAST 1/2 AND TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHWEST AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4/4’S, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20” X 10” X 4” STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER OF SECTION 33-17-13 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 112 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK “B” ON PAGES 34 TO 36 PETITIONED BY PETER FAGAN FOR A **PRIVATE ROAD** IN SECTION 33-17-13 [PACKET 340 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR’S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MARCH 26, 1881, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A **30 FOOT WIDE PRIVATE ROAD ENTIRELY ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE 1/2 SECTION LINE** ON APRIL 15, 1881 AS NOTED BY J. W. GRIFFITH, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON APRIL 5, 1881 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT 1,318’ SOUTH OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-17-13 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY. [**NOTE:** HE DOES NOT CALL THE TERMINUS THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13 BUT THAT IS THE POSITION HE INDICATES ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]  
**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
- 1) THE WEST LINE OF THIS PRIVATE ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE FOR 1,318 FEET TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 33-17-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 4) GREGORY A. MILES, L.S. 667, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MAY 21, 1982, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 1” REBAR** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13. HE EXCAVATED WITH A COUNTY BACKHOE AROUND THE BAR, BUT HE FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF THE STONE. HE SAID THAT **HE ACCEPTED** THE REBAR FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13 BASED ON THE PAROLE EVIDENCE, I.E. IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE NORTH AND SOUTH, AND IN THE CENTER OF THE TRAVELED WAY.
- 1) IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE NORTH AND SOUTH  
2) 19.90’ SOUTH TO A NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A CORNER FENCE POST  
3) 21.20’ NORTH TO A NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A CORNER FENCE POST  
4) 42.90’ ESE TO A NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
