

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 28 OF THE 8TH TERM DATED JUNE 25, 2874, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 83 TO ESTABLISH THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13 AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO THE EAST 1/2 AND TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHWEST AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4/4'S, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 16" X 4" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-17-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 1,336-1/2 WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13
 - 2) 1,336-1/2' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-13
 - 3) 1,324' SOUTH TO THE 20" X 12" X 2" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 33-17-13
 - 4) 2,648' SOUTH TO THE 16" X 10" X 3" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 33-17-13
