

NORTHWEST CORNER LOT 2 IN NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 02, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JULY 24, 2009 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09192-02, AND SURVEY F02002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-10 FOR A SURVEY OF THE NORTH LINE OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2 IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-18-10 LYING EAST OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE MK&T RAILWAY FOR AARON SEWELL, REMAX REALTY, AND CORY LEFFLER, SAID THAT HE EXCAVATED WITH A COUNTY BACKHOE OVER A LARGE AREA FOR THE STONE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2 IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-18-10, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2 ON THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVE LINE FROM THE MK&T RAILROAD MAP, I.E., IN THE CENTER OF THE COUNTY ROAD AND AT 1,699.00 FEET SOUTH TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 2-18-10. HE SAID THAT THIS LOCATION FELL IN LINE WITH A LONE POST TO THE EAST. HE NOTED ON HIS SURVEY THAT THE LATER GLO SUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTH LINE OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVE LINE IS "FRAUGHT WITH FRAUD".

- 1) 18.75' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE WEST SIDE OF A LONE CORNER FENCE POST
- 2) IN THE TRAVELED WAY OF DIRT ROAD "E" NORTH-SOUTH
- 3) 1,699.00' NORTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH "LS 752" CAP AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 2
- 4) 777.22' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH "LS 752" CAP

- 1) 1,699.00' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 2-18-10, AKA NORTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 5
- 2) 3,194.83' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 2-18-10
- 3) 2,652.31' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2 IN THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 2-18-10, AKA SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 5
- 4) 10,609.22' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH A "LS 82" CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1 IN SECTION 1-18-10

2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 24, 2011 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 11107-02, A SURVEY FOR KERMIT GROTHER TO LOCATE THE LINE BETWEEN GOVERNMENT LOT 4 AND 5 IN FRACTIONAL SECTION 3, SURVEY F03001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1 IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-18-10 ON THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVE LINE FROM HIS EXISTING REFERENCE TIES ON FILE AT THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE. HE NOTED THAT HE SET THIS CAPPED REBAR IN 2009. HE NOTED ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT THIS SURVEY IS A DIRECT RETRACEMENT OF A PERMANENT SURVEY BY MILLIKEN IN 1874 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 92.

- 1) 18.75' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE WEST FACE OF A LONE FENCE POST
- 2) IN THE TRAVELED WAY OF ROAD "E" NORTH-SOUTH
- 3) 2,673.12' WEST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH "GEOTECH" CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 4 IN SECTION 3-18-10
