- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 37 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 92 DATED AUGUST 17, 1874 TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-18-10 INTO TWO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE EAST & WEST, SAID THAT **HE SET A 15" X 10" X 6" WITNESS STONE AT 25 FEET WEST OF THE TRUE POSITION** FOR THE PERMANENT DIVISION CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY** AS THE TRUE POSITION FALLS IN A CREEK. THIS STONE IS **NOT** THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-18-10, BUT IS SHOWN HERE TO SHOW THE ORIGIN OF THIS STONE.
