

END OF COUNTY ROAD ON K. T. INDIAN RESERVE LINE IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 623 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 361 TO 364 PETITIONED BY J. W. BREWER FOR AN OUTLET ROAD ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION IN SECTION 4-18-10 [PACKET 768 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON DECEMBER 27, 1906, WAS GRANTED AS A 25 FOOT WIDE ROAD, 25 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE INDIAN LINE, ON JANUARY 11, 1907 AS NOTED BY W. H. MAPES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 12, 1907 BY ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE IN PLACE** ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-18-10 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE INDIAN LINE FOR 20.19 CHAINS TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE POINT WHERE THE SOUTH LINE OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION CROSSES THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 4-18-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MARCH 13, 1983, SAID THAT HE SEARCHED FOR BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE END OF THE ROAD ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION THAT WAS MENTIONED BY ALVA J. SMITH ON THE ORIGINAL ROAD OPENING FROM ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGE 361 IN 1906. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" CAPPED REBAR** FOR THIS CORNER, AT 20.19 CHAINS EAST OF THE STONE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 2, ACCORDING TO SMITH'S SURVEY CALL.

- 1) 12.5' SOUTH TO A 5/8" REBAR SET

HIS DRAWING ON HIS REFERENCE REPORT SHOWS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) 1,332.55' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 2
- 2) 1,335.46' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 2
