

CENTER CORNER SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 7 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 105 AND DRAWING NUMBER 53 ON PAGE 104 DATED JANUARY 1868 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 60 ACRE TRACT ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-18-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE "PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED"** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 60 ACRE TRACT
 - 2) 30.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND "PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED" AT 10 CHAINS SOUTH OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10 AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE 60 ACRE TRACT
- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 7 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 105 AND DRAWING NUMBER 54 ON PAGE 104 DATED JANUARY 1868 FOR THE SURVEY OF M. TAGUES LAND, BEING 80 ACRES ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-18-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 80 ACRE TRACT
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10

- 3) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, IN A PERMANENT SURVEY FOR THE CITY OF AMERICUS FILED MARCH 28, 1898 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE IN BOOK 68 ON PAGES 289 TO 294, SAID ON PAGE 290 THAT "THE CENTER OF SAID SECTION 11 IS 38-12/100 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTH LINE OF LOT NO. 29 IN FRACTIONAL BLOCK 4".

ON PAGE 292 HE STATES "AT THE SOUTH END OF 10TH STREET SET STONE 26" X 8" X 7" MARKED "10" ON THE NORTH SIDE. THIS STONE IS SET AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTERLINE OF 10TH STREET WITH THAT OF THE NORTH LINE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 18-RANGE 10 AND IS 196 FT. 5" FROM CENTER OF SECTION 11 ON SAID LINE".

- 4) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 143, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 224 DATED FEBRUARY 20-23, 1906 ORDERED BY G. W. FANSKA FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF 49.97 ACRES IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF 10 AND 34.50 ACRES IN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 11, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE IN PLACE IN THE CORNER OF A HEDGE FENCE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. SEE HIS FIELD NOTES IN PACKET "M 171" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON THIS SURVEY.

- 1) 20.24 CHAINS WEST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 11-18-10
- 2) 40.48 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10
- 3) 58.28 CHAINS WEST TO THE STAKE HE SET ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY
- 4) 60.82 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 11-18-10

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- 5) AI CHAMNESS, DULY DEPUTIZED TO PERFORM A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 109, SAID THAT ON JUNE 5, 1935 NOTICE WAS GIVEN BY O. D. HENRY, ENGINEER OF LYON COUNTY, KANSAS, THAT ON THE 15 DAY OF JUNE, 1936, WOULD BEGIN A SURVEY FOR LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE FOLLOWING CORNERS AS ORDERED BY MISS BESSIE PICKERING THROUGH HER ATTORNEY, OWEN S. SAMUEL OF AMERICUS, KANSAS: THE NORTHEAST CORNER, THE SOUTHWEST CORNER, AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-18-10; AND ALSO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER, THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER, THE WEST 1/4 CORNER, AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-18-10; AND ALSO THE CENTER OF SAID QUARTER SECTION, THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4; THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-18-10. THE REPORT WAS FILED ON AUGUST 20, 1936 AND THE SURVEY WAS RECORDED ON AUGUST 24, 1936. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK "R" ON PAGES 1, 53 IN THE KRETSINGER COLLECTION OF FIELD BOOKS. HE SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** HE JUDGED TO BE THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 8.00' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE, 6" X 6" WITH A CROSS [+] IN THE FLAT TOP AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF AMERICUS
 - 2) 2,661.6' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-18-10
