

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROD NUMBER 77 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 310 TO 312 PETITIONED BY E. & J. W. SCHWARTZ AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-10 [PACKET 227 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON AUGUST 5, 1880, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON OCTOBER 5, 1880, AND WAS RECORDED ON NOVEMBER 12, 1880 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND OR SET THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-10 FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE 20 CHAINS TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-10; THEN CONTINUES WEST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE LEFT SIDE PAGE 187 DATED AUGUST 5, 1880, FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-10, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-10 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE 20 CHAINS TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-10; THEN CONTINUES WEST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
