HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN VOLUME 3 ON PAGE 535 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE, SURVEY F16001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-10 FOR A SURVEY TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 16-18-10 DATED APRIL 2ND & 3RD, 1880, SAID THAT **HE SET A 14" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-18-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AND HE RESET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.09 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-10
- 2) 20.09 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-10
- 3) 40.18 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-18-10
- 4) 60.27 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HEH FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-10
