- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 61 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 209 DATED JULY 12, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE 1/2/4 AND 1/4/4 CORNERS IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-18-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE MARKED "1/16"** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-18-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 2) 1,333-1/2' SOUTH BY NOTES [1,333' ON DRAWING] TO THE STONE MARKED "1/16" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 17-18-10

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
