

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 61 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 209 DATED JULY 12, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE 1/2/4 AND 1/4/4 CORNERS IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-18-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE MARKED "1/16"** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-18-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 17-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY.**

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,314' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 17-18-10
- 2) 1,314' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-18-10
- 3) 2,640' WEST TO THE STONE MARKED "1/16" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 17-18-10
- 4) 3,966' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 17-18-10
