IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 124 DATED APRIL 6, 1882 AT THE REQUEST OF L. HARR TO ESTABLISH IN TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 10, THE 1/4 AND 1/8 CORNERS ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 18 AND THE CENTER AND 1/8 CORNERS ON THE LINE RUNNING THROUGH THE CENTER OF THE SECTION EAST TO WEST, AND ALL OTHER LINES AND CORNERS THAT MAY BE NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-18-10 AT THE "PROPER CORRECTION" BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-18-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
