

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 103 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 195 DATED MARCH 29, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF SECTION 24-18-10, TO REESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY AND ALSO THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNER ON THIS SURVEY.
- 2) **REA PIN--MUST VERIFY AND CHECK FOR OTHER MONUMENTS BEFORE USING; THIS CORNER WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY!!** REA BOOK 31 ON PAGE 3 SAYS THAT **THEY DROVE AN IRON PIN** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 24-189-10.
  - 1) 21' EAST TO A WITNESS PIN
- 3) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 18-10 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "SW CORNER NE1/4 SECTION 24-18-10"
  - 1) 21' EAST TO AN IRON PIN
- 4) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 25, 2001, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 01414-02, SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10 WAS **LOST. HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP IN A DRILL HOLE IN THE ASPHALT ROAD** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS, AS PER THE PERMANENT SURVEY BY D. T. McAULEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 195 AND DATED 1869.
  - 1) 309.55' NORTH TO THE SOUTH EDGE OF THE WEARING SURFACE OF THE BRIDGE OVER THE NEOSHO RIVER
  - 2) 0.5' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE ROAD NORTH-SOUTH [AMERICUS ROAD]
  - 3) NO OTHER REFERENCES AVAILABLE

  - 1) 2,664.22' WEST TO THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10
  - 2) 2,656.04' NORTH TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10
  - 3) 2,667.15' EAST TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10
  - 4) 2,651.72' SOUTH TO THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10
- 5) RICHARD J. IMAN, L.S. 1450, OF BG CONSULTANTS, INC. IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 20, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09-1302E, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A BROKEN LYON COUNTY CAP** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 24-18-10 USING PREVIOUS REFERENCES BY STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, DATED OCTOBER 25, 2001.
  - 1) 309.55' NORTH TO THE SOUTH EDGE OF THE WEARING SURFACE OF THE BRIDGE OVER THE NEOSHO RIVER
  - 2) 0.5' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE ROAD NORTH-SOUTH [AMERICUS ROAD]
  - 3) NO OTHER REFERENCES AVAILABLE
