

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 180 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 27" X 15" X 2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 21 & 28-18-10.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.05 CHAINS WEST TO THE 28" X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 20, 21, 28 & 29-18-10
 - 2) 40.05 CHAINS EAST TO THE 27" X 17" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 21, 22, 27 & 28-18-10

- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 119 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 206 & 207 AND CONTINUED AT THE BOTTOM OF PAGE 208 DATED MAY 22 & 27, 1869 TO SURVEY THE EAST 1/2, AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-18-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF SECTION 21-18-10 ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 79 RODS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 21-18-10
 - 2) 158 RODS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-10
 - 3) 158 RODS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-10
 - 4) 319 RODS, 2 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-10

- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 77 DATED DECEMBER 15, 1884 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-10 FOR N. BRISLIN, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT HE **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 28-18-10 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2-1/2 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-18-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 4) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 282 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 78 TO 80 PETITIONED BY NEIL BRISLEN AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-10 [PACKET 554 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON DECEMBER 15, 1884, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 7, 1885 AS NOTED BY P. Y. HALLBERG, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON MARCH 18, 1885 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-18-10 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2-1/2 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-18-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY

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- 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 30, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 30 DATED MAY 9, 1884 AT THE REQUEST OF N. CAMPBELL, W. BRISLIN, AND CARLYSLE TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 29 AND THE NORTH, SOUTH AND EAST LINES OF SECTION 30, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 18-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE GOVERNMENT STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS FILED MAY 17, 1884 AND RECORDED JANUARY 17, 1887 IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 16 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE, AND SURVEY F29002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-10.
- HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 2,595' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND DOWN AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-10, BUT EVIDENTLY IN THE RIGHT PLACE AS IT CORRESPONDS WITH FENCES BUILT YEAR BEFORE
 - 2) 5,221' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-10
 - 3) 6,633.5' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 27-18-10
 - 4) 7,946' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-10
 - 5) 2,642' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND DOWN AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29-18-10 AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29-18-10, AFTER HE RAN THE SECTION LINES FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-18-10 SOUTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29-18-10
 - 6) 3,965' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-10
 - 7) 5,288' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-18-10
 - 8) 6,611' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE NORTH PERMANENT NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-10
 - 9) 7,934' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-18-10
 - 10) 10,574' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-18-10
 - 11) 13,078' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-18-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE
