

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 17 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 17 & 18, RANGE 11, DATED JUNE 16 1882, SAID THAT **HE FELL 18-1/2 FEET NORTH OF THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER** ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-18-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

**HIS NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE FOR 1,318' TO THE APPROXIMATE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-17-11 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE WITH A DEVIATION TO THE NORTH FOR 1,326 FEET TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 32 & 5, THEN CONTINUES WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 31, 32, 5 & 6 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY
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- 2) ON PAGE 35 OF A FIELD BOOK LABELED "BOOK 17 ROAD PROFILES 1935" IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR A "SECTION LINE SURVEY ON THE SOUTH SIDES OF SECTIONS 33 & 32, T17S, R11E" DATED FEBRUARY 5, 1935, IT SHOWS A "**STAKE SET-1/8 SECT.**". THERE ARE NO TIES TO THIS CORNER ON THIS PAGE. **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
