

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 29 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 123 & 124 DATED MARCH 24, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF R. DENNIS'S, MILLER'S, AND A PART OF C. DRAKE'S LAND, BEING THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8, AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, AND THE SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE WEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11 ON THIS SURVEY.

- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 142, A **PRIVATE SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 223 DATED APRIL 2, 1906 TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE EAST END OF A LINE IN THE CENTER OF AN ABANDONED LANE BETWEEN THE PROPERTY OF J. F. McLAUGHLAN AND JOHN C. CRENSHAW IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11, SAID THAT HE FOUND A FENCE ON THE 1/2/4 LINE THAT EXTENDS TO THE EAST ON THIS **PRIVATE SURVEY**. HE DID **NOT** MENTION FINDING McAULEY'S STONE. **HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
 - 1) 20.13 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 9-18-11 ON LINE WITH A HEDGE TO THE WEST AND 43 LINKS EAST OF A HEDGE EXTENDING NORTH
 - 2) 0.72 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE CENTER OF THE END OF THE LANE TO THE WEST
 - 3) 20.12 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-18-11
 - 4) 21.37 CHAINS NORTH TO THE **WITNESS STONE** HE FOUND IN PLACE AT 26 LINKS EAST OF A FENCE
