

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 29 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 123 & 124 DATED MARCH 24, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF R. DENNIS'S, MILLER'S, AND A PART OF C. DRAKE'S LAND, BEING THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8, AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, AND THE SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER OF SECTION 9 ON THIS SURVEY.

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 28, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03197-02, SURVEY F09001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 FOR A SUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 9-18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9 ON TRUE LINE AND HALF-WAY BETWEEN THE CENTER CORNER AND THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9.
 - 1) 73.7' SSE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
 - 2) 36.65' NE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NORTH BRACE POST
 - 3) 30.8' EAST TO A LINE OF FENCE NORTH-SOUTH
 - 4) 25.0' EAST TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP SET
 - 5) 2.0' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE ROAD NORTH-SOUTH

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 1,316.80' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR OVER THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9
 - 2) 1,316.80' NORTH TO A 3/4" REBAR FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9
 - 3) 1,302.50' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE CENTER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9
 - 4) 2,605.01' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9
