BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JANUARY 11, 2006, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 05395-02, SURVEY F10006 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-11 FOR DOUG COFFMAN, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 10-18-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS.
 - 1) 2.75' SSW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A FENCE POST
 - 2) 13.5' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE SOUTH
 - 3) 13.4' WSW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A FENCE POST
 - 4) 7.1' NE TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A 24" ELM TREE
 - 5) IN LINE WITH THE REMAINS OF AN OLD FENCE TO THE NORTH

 - 1) 2,648.62' WEST TO THE #6 REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-11
 - 2) 2,649.01' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-11
 - 3) 2,672.88' EAST TO THE COTTON GIN SPINDLE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE N1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-11
 - 4) 1,318.18' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE N1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-11
 - 5) 2,636.35' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH A KDOT CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-18-11
