BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 28, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03197-02, SURVEY F09001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 FOR A SUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 9-18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11 ON TRUE LINE AND HALF-WAY BETWEEN THE EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-18-11.
 - 1) 37.1' NE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN THE SIDE OF A BRACE POST
 - 2) 24.8' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 3) 25.0' WEST TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP SET
 - 4) 1.0' SOUTH OF A FENCE LINE
 - 5) IN THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD "K" NORTH-SOUTH **HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
 - 1) 1,322.46' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11
 - 2) 1,322.45' NORTH TO THE #6 SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11
 - 3) 3,967.36' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP IN A MONUMENT WELL HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SEC. 9-18-11
 - 4) 1,302.51' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE CENTER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11
 - 5) 2,605.01' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9-18-11
