BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED APRIL 14, 2005, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 05113-02, SURVEY F11001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 7.0 ACRE TRACT IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 7-18-11 FOR DAVID HILL, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 11-18-11 FROM A PREVIOUS SURVEY.
