

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED FEBRUARY 24, 2005, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 05040-02, SURVEY F15003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 30.36 ACRE TRACT IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 15-18-11 FOR PAUL HANCOCK AND ALICE GATEWOOD, SAID THAT THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-11 ON TRUE LINE AND HALF-WAY BETWEEN THE WEST QUARTER CORNER AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-11.

- 1) 25.0' EAST TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET
- 2) 27.6' NW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
- 3) 11.0' NORTH TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE WEST
- 4) 2.0' WEST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF GRAVEL COUNTY ROAD "K" NORTH-SOUTH

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,327.35' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-11
- 2) 1,327.34' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" SQUARE REBAR FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-11
- 3) 1,325.41' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE CENTER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-11
- 4) 2,650.44' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-11
