

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MARCH 22, 2004, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 04024-02, SURVEY F16002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 FOR A SURVEY OF THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST HALF OF THE OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16-18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 16.

- 1) 9.0' WEST TO A LINE OF TREES TO THE SOUTH
- 2) 55.5' SOUTH TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN AN ELM TREE
- 3) 39.15' SW TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A HEDGE TREE
- 4) IN THE CENTER OF THE TRAVELED WAY

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,291.66' WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 SECTION 16
- 2) 1,291.66' EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16
- 3) 3,889.93' EAST TO A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16
- 4) 2,649.28' SOUTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16—FALLS IN A CREEK
