

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 117 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 39 DATED AUGUST 10, 1873 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 18-18-11, THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18, THE CENTER CORNER, AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 BY A LINE EAST AND WEST, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-18-11 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-18-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-18-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,317' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-18-11
- 2) 1,317' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-18-11
