

CENTER CORNER SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 10 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 7 DATED APRIL 1858, FOR A SURVEY OF THE TOWN SITE OF FREMONT, DID NOT MENTION THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-81-11 ON THIS SURVEY WHEN HE RAN THE LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11 TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11, NOR DID HE NOTE THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THESE TWO STONES.
 - 2) H. S. SLEEPER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1859 TO 1862, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 24 & 25 [PACKET 437 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] FOR THE "FOREST HILL TO AMERICUS" ROAD IN BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY DATED APRIL 1859 FOR THE "FOREST HILL TO AMERICUS ROAD" SURVEYED MARCH 30 THROUGH APRIL 1, 1859 AND ESTABLISHED APRIL 27, 1859 IN THE COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL ON PAGE 66, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11 ON THE WEST LINE OF THE TOWN OF FREMONT ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE THROUGH THE TOWN OF FREMONT TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11 AT A TURN TO THE SOUTH
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE NORTH CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11 AT A TURN TO THE NORTHWESTERLY TO THE CITY OF AMERICUS AND THE END OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 3) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 120 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 207 & 208 DATED MAY 25 & 26, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND SITUATED IN SECTION 21-18-11, TO REESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNERS ON THE EASTERN AND WESTERN BOUNDARIES, AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 21, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 80 RODS, 2-1/2 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 21-18-11
 - 2) 160 RODS, 5 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11
 - 3) 79 RODS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 21-18-11
 - 4) 158 RODS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11
 - 4) **REA PIN—MUST VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING; THIS CORNER WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR.** REA BOOK 31 ON PAGE 1 SAYS THAT **THEY DROVE AN IRON PIN** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-11.
 - 1) 25' NORTH TO A WITNESS PIN
 - 5) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "SW CORNER NE1/4 SECTION 21-18-11". **VERIFY BEFORE USING AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
