- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 2 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 57 DATED FEBRUARY 10, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 22 & 27-18-11 AND TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22 AND SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 22 BY A LINE NORTH & SOUTH AND THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22 BY A LINE NORTH & SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A 12" X 10" X 8" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-18-11 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE 12" X 12" X 10" BURNT ARCH BRICK FROM THE BRICK KILN THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-18-11 AND THE 24" X 16" X 4" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-18-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE REFERENCED SURVEY NUMBER 45 OF THE 7TH TERM AND SURVEY NUMBER 32 OF THE 6TH TERM.
