- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, BY D. W. BOWMAN, DEPUTY, IN SURVEY NUMBER 62 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 162 DATED MAY 30, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY CLARK AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 26-18-11 TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 INTO TWO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE RUNNING EAST AND WEST, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-18-11 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-18-11 AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 26-18-11 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 80 RODS, 10 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-18-11
- 2) 80 RODS, 10 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 26-18-11
