- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 33 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 128 DATED APRIL 10, 1868 TO SURVEY J. A. FILINER'S LAND, BEING THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND 20 ACRES MORE OR LESS OF THE WEST END OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND ALSO TO DIVIDE EQUALLY 60 ACRES MORE OR LESS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 26 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE POST HE SET FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 26 ON THIS SURVEY.
