

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 2 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 57 DATED FEBRUARY 10, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 22 & 27-18-11 AND TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22 AND SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 22 BY A LINE NORTH & SOUTH AND THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22 BY A LINE NORTH & SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A 16" X 18" X 4" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF 22 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 21, 22, 27 & 28 AND THE 24" X 16" X 4" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 22 & 27 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE REFERENCED SURVEY NUMBER 45 OF THE 7TH TERM AND SURVEY NUMBER 32 OF THE 6TH TERM.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,316' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SEC. 21, 22, 27 & 28
- 2) 1,316' EAST TO THE 24" X 16" X 4" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22
- 3) 2,632' EAST TO THE 18" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 22
- 4) 3,948' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SEC. 22, 23, 26 & 27
