

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 32 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 127 DATED APRIL 4, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF WILLIAM STANLEY'S AND OTHERS LAND, BEING THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER OF SECTION 27 ON THIS SURVEY.
  
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 24 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 79 DATED MAY 14, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 14" X 10" X 2" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND "ALREADY ESTABLISHED" AT THE CENTER CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 26 & 27 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
  - 1) 1,314' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND "ALREADY ESTABLISHED" AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 27
  - 2) 1,314' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 27 & 28
  - 3) 1,329' SOUTH TO THE 14" X 8" X 5" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 27
  - 4) 2,658' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 27
