

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE LEFT SIDE PAGE 163 DATED FEBRUARY 10, 1879, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-18-11 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 3,960' NORTH ON THE SECTION LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-11
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- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 20 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 78 TO 80 FOR A PETITION BY PETER SLISHER AND OTHERS FOR THE VACATION AND RELOCATION OF A COUNTY ROAD IN SECTION 29-18-11 [PACKET 13 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON FEBRUARY 29, 1879, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON APRIL 7, 1879, AND WAS RECORDED ON APRIL 15, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-18-11 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 3,960 FEET TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-11; THEN EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2,640 FEET TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-11 FOR THE TERMINATION OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
