

**NORTHWEST CORNER OF “WHEAT LAND ESTATES” ON THE WEST LINE OF THE  
NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JULY 14, 2003, **FOUND A 1/2” IRON PIN AT 5” BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE ASPHALT ROAD AT THIS CORNER, AND LOWERED IT TO 9” BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE PRIOR TO SCARIFYING THE ROAD. THE PIN IS PLATTED AT 1,498 FEET NORTH OF THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-18-11, BUT I DID NOT VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF THE POSITION—I JUST LOWERED IT SO IT WOULD NOT BE DISTURBED BY THE RECONSTRUCTION OF GRAPHIC ARTS ROAD.**
  - 1) 31.3’ EAST TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE SOUTH FACE OF A RAILROAD TIE CORNER FENCE POST-FENCES TO THE NORTH & EAST
  - 2) 56.2’ SW TO THE TOP NORTHERNMOST CORNER OF A CURVED STONE DRIVEWAY FENCE TO THE EAST
  - 3) 28’ SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF “HUGHES LANE” TO THE EAST
  - 4) IN THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF GRAPHIC ARTS ROAD
