

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 54 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 153 DATED MAY 22, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF ANN OWEN'S LAND, BEING ALL THAT PART OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-11, AND ALSO THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER OF SECTION 33 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 80 RODS, 11 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33
- 2) 80 RODS, 11 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE ESTABLISHED BY A FORMER COUNTY SURVEYOR FOUND AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 33
- 3) 240 RODS, 20 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33 FROM WITNESS TREES
