

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 10, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 10 DATED FEBRUARY 10-12, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 25-26-35-36 IN TOWNSHIP 18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 36 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,319-1/2' WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 36
- 2) 1,319-1/2' EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SEC. 36
