

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

1) W. A. ELA, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 136 & 137 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-11 PETITIONED BY A. E. RHODES AND OTHERS THAT WAS SURVEYED ON JULY 24, 1869 AND ESTABLISHED AND FILED FOR RECORD ON OCTOBER 4, 1869 AS NOTED BY J. L. WILLIAMS, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT HE COMMENCED THIS ROAD SURVEY AT 80 RODS NORTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11 AND RAN EAST TO INTERSECT THE LAWRENCE & EMPORIA ROAD. THE LAW OF 1869 PROVIDES 40 FEET WIDTH ON SECTION LINE ROADS. SEE THE COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL ON PAGE 284.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/2/4 SECTION LINE TO INTERSECT THE LAWRENCE & EMPORIA ROAD IN THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 36-18-11
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE 1/2/4 SECTION LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY AT 80 RODS NORTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11

2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 174 & 175 [PACKET 22 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] PETITIONED BY ARTHUR PLUMB TO **VACATE** A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-12 THAT HE SURVEYED ON JULY 14, 1871, AND WAS ORDERED **VACATED** AND THE VACATION RECORDED ON SEPTEMBER 4, 1871 AS NOTED BY DAVID S. GILMORE, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND** THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 36-18-11 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD **VACATION** SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD TO BE **VACATED** EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/2/4 SECTION LINE FOR 136-8/10 RODS TO INTERSECT THE LAWRENCE AND EMPORIA ROAD TO END THIS ROAD **VACATION** SURVEY

3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JANUARY 23, 2008, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 07438-02, SURVEYS F35005 AND F35006 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-11 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 15.76 ACRE TRACT IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11 FOR FULLER, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11 ON TRUE LINE AND AT HALF WAY BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-18-11. THIS 1/2" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP IS ALSO THE P.O.B. OF THE 15.76 ACRE TRACT.

- 1) 43.35' WSW TO A SPIKE & WASHER IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
- 2) 35.2' SW TO A SPIKE & WASHER IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
- 3) 24.0' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE SOUTH
- 4) IN THE TRAVELED WAY OF GRAVEL ROAD "M" NORTH-SOUTH
- 5) IN THE TRAVELED WAY OF GRAVEL ROAD 197 TO THE WEST

HIS DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,327.28' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11
- 2) 877.14' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 15.76 ACRE TRACT
- 3) 1,327.28' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11

- 4) 3,981.84' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR IN A MONUMENT WELL HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11
- 5) 785.76' WEST TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 15.76 ACRE TRACT AS WITNESSED BY THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET 17.00' SOUTH
- 6) 2,638.23' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11
