

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 46 & 47 FOR ROAD NUMBER 115 BY A PETITION BY G. A. SPENCER [PACKET 357 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED JUNE 1881, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE *NORTHEAST 1/4* OF SECTION 5-18-12 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD. [**NOTE:** HIS NOTES STATE THAT HE ENDED THIS ROAD SURVEY AT 3,960 FEET SOUTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 32-18-12, MAKING THE LOCATION IN THE *SOUTHEAST 1/4* OF SECTION 5-18-12 – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 602, COUNTY SURVEYOR]

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE RIGHT PAGE 222 DATED JUNE 27, 1881, FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIPS 16-12, 17-12 & 18-12 APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE *NORTHEAST 1/4* OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-18-12 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES WITH AN ANGLE IN THE *NORTHEAST 1/4* OF SECTION 20-16-12 TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE *NORTHEAST CORNER* OF SECTION 20-16-12 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
