

**CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 08, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED AUGUST 22, 2008 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 08266-02, SURVEY F08002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-12 FOR A SURVEY OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 8-18-12 FOR WHITMORE/BARRETT, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/16TH CORNERS OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12.
 - 1) 9.3' ESE TO A 40 D NAIL IN THE TOP OF A HEDGE FENCE POST
 - 2) 17.3' EAST TO A 40 D NAIL IN THE TOP OF A HEDGE FENCE POST
 - 3) 2.4' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE EAST AND WEST

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

 - 1) 1,322.48' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12
 - 2) 1,325.66' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12
 - 3) 1,322.46' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12, THAT FALLS IN A TREE, AND IS WITNESSED BY 1/2" REBARS WITH HIS "LS 752" CAPS HE SET AT 6.0' NORTH AND 2.0' WEST OF THE TRUE CORNER
 - 4) 1,325.66' SOUTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12

- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED NOVEMBER 9, 2012, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 12258-02, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 1/2" IRON PIN WITH HIS "S. BROSEMER" CAP IN CONCRETE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12 FROM HIS EXISTING REFERENCES ON FILE AT THE LYON COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE DATED AUGUST 2008.
 - 1) 2.35' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE RUNNING EAST-WEST
 - 2) 9.20' EAST-SOUTHEAST TO A 40 D NAIL IN THE TOP OF A BRACE POST
 - 3) 17.30' EAST-SOUTHEAST TO A 40 D NAIL IN THE TOP OF A BRACE POST
