

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 161, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 161 DATED MARCH 30 & 31, 1887 ORDERED BY WILLIAM ELSDON TO SURVEY THE WEST 1/2 AND THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-12, SAID THAT HE SET A **TEMPORARY STAKE** FOR THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-18-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-18-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,326-1/4' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-18-12
- 2) 1,326-1/4' SOUTH TO THE 4" X 10" X 14" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-18-12
- 3) 3,978-3/4' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-18-12
- 4) 1,325-1/2' EAST TO THE 4" X 12" X 24" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-12
- 5) 2,651' EAST TO THE 2-1/2" X 12" X 20" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-18-12
