

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 36, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 36 DATED MAY 26, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 14-18-12 AND TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4, THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-18-12 BY LINES RUNNING EAST & WEST, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-18-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-18-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,327' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 14-18-12
- 2) 1,327' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-18-12
- 3) 2,654' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 14-18-12
- 4) 3,981' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 14-18-12
