

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 68 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 125 DATED MARCH 24, 1875 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE CORNERS TO THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST AS STONE WAS NOT AVAILABLE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-12 AND THE POST THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED THAT THE PARTIES FOR WHOM THIS SURVEY WAS MADE AGREED TO REPLACE ALL THE POSTS THAT HE SET ON THIS SURVEY WITH STONE CORNERS.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,332-1/2' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-12
- 2) 1,332-1/2' WEST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-12
- 3) 3,993-1/2' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-12
- 4) 1,323-1/3' SOUTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12
- 5) 2,647' SOUTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12
