

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 53, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 234 DATED JULY 5, 1902 ORDERED BY JOHN BLAHUT, CASPER TROLL, AND THE ESTATE OF WALTER S. WILSEY TO SURVEY AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-18-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 1/8TH STONE** ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-18-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 80, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 44" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.10 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22-18-12
- 2) 100.49 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-12
- 3) 140.68-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 24" X 12" X 2" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-12
- 4) 180.88 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 15" X 8" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-12
- 5) 221.07-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-18-12
- 6) 261.25-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-18-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
